PROFILE *Brian William Mudge*

Born 1957. Married 2 children. After being, in his own words " a good amateur" turned professional in 1979 and commenced his career at Staverton Park after the world famous coach David Leadbetter left for America.. He became a fully qualified PGA professional in 1982. Brian moved on in 1993 for his first stint at Overstone before moving to Collingtree in 2007 where he built up a 165 strong junior academy. In 2009 he formed part of a group setting up New Malton Golf Club in Cambridgeshire which sadly failed to be financially viable. Interestingly this became one of only 6 clubs in the world to be "100% organic" and in recognition received a Green Apple award from the government in 2010. It was ahead of its time but the use of chemicals is a problem that all clubs are now facing. He returned for his second stint at Overstone in 2015 to help create a strong junior section as well as being heavily involved in the Junior Scholarship scheme which helped the club win the nationally acclaimed Sir Michael Bonallack Award in 2019.. Brian's greatest enjoyment is seeing all golfers, but particularly the Juniors improving their skills. His ultimate coaching achievement to date is guiding Gary Wolstenholme to his British Amateur Championship win in 1991. Gary is still the most capped British Amateur golfer of all time.

Brian enjoys all genres of music and is presently learning to play the guitar which he reckons is harder than golf. Not sure about that personally!
