NAME & NUMBER	WHAT IS IT?	OTHER INFORMATION
1 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS	The premier competition of the year and the only one that spans 2 days over a weekend. There are 3 trophies which are – men's scratch, ladies scratch & club handicap champions.	Strict qualifying criteria which are to submit 3 qualifying cards in the year leading up to the competition.
2 MONTHLY MEDALS	There are monthly medals on the first weekend of every month – either on a Saturday or a Sunday – and on the first Wednesday of every month. Some medals are drawn, and some are not	Entry closes on the Saturday or Sunday prior to the comp at 3.00pm for Saturday or Sunday Medals. Mid-week medals can be entered on the day.
3 STABLEFORD COMPETITIONS	Held on the second & third Wednesdays of every month (mostly). Also 2 competitions per month at weekends.	Entry on the day in the pro-shop but book tee times with other members as wanted.
4 CAPTAINS TROPHY	Held in early April. A shotgun start with registration on the day but entries in advance. The only honours board trophy that can be won in a day!	Signup online with Masterscoreboard
5 WRIGHT TROPHY	The annual pairs knockout trophy played in the summer. You choose your partner, enter the competition by the closing date and then the draw will be made.	All games to be played by specified dates or both parties will be disqualified.
6 DARO CUP	The annual singles knockout cup played in the summer. You enter the competition, by the closing date, and then the draw will be made.	All games to be played by the specified dates or both parties will be disqualified.
7 PLAYER OF THE YEAR	Played in the autumn. A singles knockout competition for the winners of the 16 major competitions by invitation only.	Strict eligibility criteria are applied.
9 Scratch Knock out	Annual knock out competition played off scratch	The top 16 scratch players based on their results in the club championship are invited to play.
9 ORDER OF MERRIT PAIRS	You choose your own partner and there are nine pair's competitions throughout the year. Each round has a different format, and six of the nine rounds count to your final score. 10	Enter online
10 FRIENDSHIP TROPHY	Pairs better ball competition, with a shotgun start, played on a Saturday in June. You choose your own friend!	
11 CAPTAINS DAY	A fundraising day for the captains Charity which is a team format as decided by the captains each year.	Format decided by the captains so different every year.
12 CAPTAINS PRO CHALLENGE	A chance to play with a partner against the Captain and the Pro. Dates are set aside throughout the summer and culminates in the Captain Pro Shoot Out.	
13 INTERNATIONAL DAY	A team competition between England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland / Rest of the World.	Enter based on your geographic preference.
14 STEWART WRIGHT SALVER	Annual mixed pairs competition. Foursome's format.	Enter online
15 AUTUMN TEXAS	A shotgun start competition which is drawn.

16 STUART KENNEDY PRESSURE BALL	A shotgun start team competition, played in the autumn, which is a Stableford format.	Enter your own team
17 CHRISTMAS SPIRITS TEXAS SCRAMBLE	A drawn Stableford competition with a shotgun start where the prizes allow you to top up your drink's cabinet in readiness for Christmas!	
18 CAPTAINS DRIVE- IN	A shotgun start competition held in early December which is also a celebration of the new Captains (Men's, Ladies, Seniors & Juniors) first day.	
19 ECLECTIC	Annual fun summer competition where your best score on each hole in certain competitions is recorded.	
20 MIXED SUMMER GREENSOMES KNOCK OUT SHIELD	The annual pairs knockout shield played in the summer. You choose your partner, enter the competition by the closing date and then the draw will be made.	All games to be played by specified dates or both parties will be disqualified
21 OVERSTONE PARK TEAMS	Overstone Park Golf Club enters Mens, Ladies, Senior & Junior teams in various County & National competitions.	Captain's details are listed in the roundel.

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR COMPETITIONS

Members can sign up for competitions in the club shop. In the online diary or masterscoreboard you will find a list of competitions available to sign up for. Club shop staff will assist you if you ask them. Please note the majority of competitions will close 6 days before its commencement.

- All competitions must be paid for in cash or using the online payment facility.

Master Scoreboard provides the following:


- 1) Handicaps which are updated regularly after every competition

3) Draws for future competitions such as Monthly Medals, Club Championships, Wright Trophy & Daro Cup etc.

OBTAINING A HANDICAP

A new member who has never had a handicap previously must complete 3 cards and have the cards signed by a member of OPL with a valid WHS handicap.





The 3 cards should be placed in an envelope and placed in the box upstairs to the left of the barmarked as New Handicap 1, 2 & 3. Please also place in the envelope your Membership Number, contact telephone number DOB and email address. Once all three cards have been entered on to Master Scoreboard and a competition handicap issues, the Handicap Secretary will email a letter to you confirming your new playing handicap.

Once a handicap has been issued, for the handicap to be maintained, 3 qualifying competitions per year must be played.

- The Roundel: This is by the changing rooms near the 1st tee. The code for the changing rooms can be obtained from the Club Shop. There are notice boards in this area with information on many golf related activities.
- Club Diary is available on line on the website.
- Committee Members: All members have their photographs and positions clearly shown in the roundel, they will be happy to answer any questions or queries.
- Club Professional: Brian Mudge is our club professional, and his details can be found in the club shop. Brian organises individual & group coaching sessions for all abilities, has a personalised golf club fitting service and has a golf simulator in his studio.
- Posters: There are posters in the club house, club shop & roundel (by the changing rooms downstairs) which have information on forthcoming competitions, including entry fees.
- Facebook: There is a Facebook page run by members for members. This site will get you a rapid response on any subject and members will answer your questions. In addition, you can ask for other members to join you in competitions. The group is called Overstone Park Golf Members and although it is a closed group if you ask to join you will very quickly be accepted. There is also Overstone Park golf club.
- Ladies, Seniors and Junior Sections: Overstone Golf also have Ladies, Seniors and Junior sections who run their own competitions in addition to the ones listed in this document. Further detail can be obtained from the Lady, Senior and Junior Captains, details of which can be found in the club diary.
